Cookies on Trading212.com

Trading 212 AU Pty Ltd ACN 660 342 763 ("**the Company**", "**Trading 212**", "**we**", "**our**" or "**us**") is an online share trading platform operator regulated by the Australian Securities & Investments Commission ("**ASIC**") under Australian Financial Service Licensee (AFSL number 541122).

What are cookies?

Cookies are small pieces of text stored on your computer when you visit a website or a mobile app. They are not programs and cannot be executed as code or deliver viruses – instead, cookies act more like a passport, which allows the Website to recognise your browser.

Most websites which you visit will use cookies to improve your user experience, determine the type of browser and settings you are using or allow site owners and third-party advertisers to tailor content to your preferences. Each cookie is unique and contains some anonymous information such as a unique identifier, site name, digits, and letters. Cookies are managed by your browser.

Cookies have different durations for the various kinds of information they collect. For example, a session cookie is used to manage registration/login, access to reserved features and ensure the correct functioning of the website. Session cookies are stored temporarily during a browsing session and are deleted from the user's device when the browser is closed. Persistent cookies are saved on your computer for a fixed period (usually a year or longer) and are not deleted when the browser is closed (unless deleted by the user before the expiry date).

Cookies may be provided by us or by third parties. Cookies provided by us, are called “first-party cookies” and they can only be read by our Website. Cookies set by other parties are called “third-party cookies”. Third-party cookies enable third-party features or functionality to be provided on or through the website or service you are using (such as advertising, interactive content, and analytics). The third parties that set these cookies can recognise your computer both when it visits the website or service in question and also when it visits certain other websites or services.

What types of cookies do we use?

Essential cookies

Essential (also known as “strictly necessary”) cookies are cookies that are needed to provide an online service at someone’s request. All cookies used by our mobile apps are essential cookies. Such cookies do not require consent as these are essential for providing the service that the user asks for.

Performance cookies

Performance (also known as “necessary functional”) cookies collect analytical information on how visitors use the Website, such as page visits and page load speed. With solely this information, a visitor cannot be identified. Performance cookies do not require consent.

Functionality cookies

These cookies allow our Website to remember visitors’ choices, such as user name and language, and provide enhanced, personalised results. These cookies generally require consent.

Targeting or advertising cookies

These cookies are used to deliver adverts that are more relevant to the user as they are based on their interests. These cookies often are third-party cookies. Such cookies always require consent.

In addition, we use Google Analytics and other Google services such as Google Tag Manager to analyse the use of our Website. Google Analytics generate statistical and other

information about Website use by means of cookies on users' computers. The information generated in relation to our Website is used to create reports about the use of the Website. How do you provide consent?

You give your consent when you select 'Accept all cookies' on the pop-up that will appear whenever you use our Website. You can always choose which cookies you allow us to use, apart from essential and performance cookies, which can't be turned off. If you change your mind and want to withdraw your consent, you can do so at any time, just select the cookies you want to accept on the pop-up or via your internet browser. You can read more about this in our 'Changing Cookies Settings' section below.

Why do we use cookies?

We use cookies to:

- help us understand how our Website and mobile app are being used to analyse our Services and make improvements where necessary;
- personalise our Services and provide a better experience for you;
- allow us to see what pages, links and sub-domains visitors have visited so we can provide more relevant ads;
- monitor our performance;
- optimise your trading experience, including remembering your preferences, location, preferred language, browser and other details;
- authenticate your identity for security purposes; and
- maintain our Website and certain functions available on it.

Changing Cookies Settings

As set out above, some cookies are required for technical reasons for our Website and applications to operate. Others are optional and enhance your experience or provide you with targeted content.

You have the right to decide whether to accept or reject cookies. If you choose to reject cookies, you may still use the website though your access to some functionality and areas of the Website may be restricted. If you block cookies, you will not be able to use all the features on our Website and Trading Platform and may have a different experience of our Services.

You can also delete cookies already stored on your computer. Again, doing this may have a negative impact on the usability of our Services.

As the means by which you can refuse cookies through your web browser controls vary from browser-to-browser, you should visit your browser's help menu for more information. It is necessary to follow the instructions provided by the web browser, which are usually located within the 'Help', 'Tools' or 'Edit' menus.
